## PRIMARY PURPOSE:

The Duncanville ISD Police Department is looking for an Assistant Chief of Police that is willing to work in a school setting. Duncanville Independent School District is located in southern Dallas County, Dallas Texas. Duncanville ISD has 17 campuses with 13 of the 17 rated Exemplary or Recognized by the TEA <u>Texas Education Agency</u>, and the district's ratings continue to outperform those of the surrounding districts (Cedar Hill, DeSoto, Lancaster, Dallas, and Grand Prairie). Duncanville ISD also outperforms many of the school districts throughout the Dallas-Fort Worth area.

The Assistant Chief will assist the Chief of Police in managing the District Police Department. Responsible for the supervision of personnel and the administrative duties in the department, in addition to performing the full range duties of a police officer. Maintain and enforce municipal, county, and state ordinances and laws as well as policies, directives, and standards of the district.

- A minimum of two (2) years served in a Lieutenant or Deputy Chief position preferred
